With the strength of LP® SolidStart® I-Joists combined with the structural stability of LP® TopNotch® Sub-Flooring panels, the ducts run through holes cut in the web of the I-joists without compromising the integrity of the floors.

"The home has a lot of open space. These LP products allowed us to create larger spaces and an open floor plan with the strength and length of their materials," Hutchinson said. "The components of the LP floor system are designed

to work together. Framers love it. LP SolidStart I-Joists have a wider flange, so you get a great nailing surface. And it definitely gives you the pounds per square inch you need, even under rock walls or heavy bathtubs."

LSL is stronger and straighter than traditional lumber and doesn't have any of its natural imperfections. Plus LSL won't warp, shrink or twist, so it can help reduce callbacks.
