

Dress Properly:

Handling and installing LP products may produce dust when cut which can irritate eyes, nose, throat, skin and upper respiratory tract; therefore, we recommend the following be worn when using LP FlameBlock sheathing.

- ANSI approved safety glasses
- Appropriate gloves
- NIOSH approved dust mask
- · Long sleeves and/or protective coveralls
- Long pants

Maintain a Clean and Safe Work Area:

Maintaining a proper work area is essential to the safe handling and installation of LP OSB products.

- Use (sand, saw, etc.) outdoors or in well ventilated areas
- Store panels flat to prevent the product from sliding or falling
- Keep work areas free of scrap materials to minimize dust and prevent tripping hazards
- Follow best practice for site management and disposal of waste
- Wash hands before eating
