OVERVIEW

Through the LP Foundation, we provide products and funding to support qualified nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations and public schools.

The LP Foundation also matches 100% of employee contributions to our annual America’s Charities and United Way employee giving campaigns.

FOCUS AREAS



The LP Foundation focuses its giving in four areas

- Shelter
- Education
- Environment
- Social Services

In addition to the four focus areas, the LP Foundation matches, dollar-for-dollar, employee giving to LP approved charities, including America's Charities organizations and the United Way.

ELIGIBILITY



The LP Foundation awards grants on a quarterly basis throughout the year.

For an organization to be eligible for funding, it must:

- Have 501(c)(3) nonprofit status or be a public school
- Operate or have programs within one or more of LP's four focus areas
- Serve communities where LP employees and customers live and work
- Priority is given to organizations or projects in which LP employees are involved as volunteers.

The LP Foundation may, at its sole discretion, discontinue accepting unsolicited proposals at any time during the year. Please check the LP Web site at www.lpcorp.com to determine whether the Foundation is accepting grant proposals.

HOW TO APPLY



Organizations seeking funding from the LP Foundation are required to submit a Proposal Letter. The letter must include the following information and format:

Contact information

- Organization name, address, phone, fax and Web address
- Contact name, title, phone, fax and e-mail

Organization Information

- Organization mission statement, purpose and goals
- Demographics and geographic location of served population
- Organization's total revenue, assets and expenses

Project Information

- Provide the project name
- Describe the project and its desired outcomes
- Describe how the project supports the LP Foundation focus areas
- Grant amount requested
- Total project budget

The proposal should not exceed two pages, double spaced.
