WINTER



TOP INSTALLATION TIP
CHOOSE MATERIALS WISELY

Not all siding is created equal. Because of its advanced durability and stability, engineered wood siding is built to sustain cold, fluctuating temperatures.



TOP MAINTENANCE TRICK
FIGHT FROZEN PIPES

If pipes aren't primed for winter, it can wreak havoc on a home. In addition to ensuring your siding material can stand up to frigid weather, insulate exposed pipes, seal gaps and repair leaks before freezing temperatures arrive.

TOP INSTALLATION TIP
COMBAT SPRING SHOWERS

Installing gutters is a home's first line of defense against the rain damage spring showers can bring, diverting the water flow from potentially harming siding by discoloration, shortening the paint life and increasing the chance of fungus and mildew.



TOP MAINTENANCE TRICK
KEEP IT CLEAN

Spring cleaning isn't just limited to the indoors. To remove the natural build-up of dust, dirt or stains on siding, use a cloth, sponge or soft brush with a mild solution and water. Gently rinse with water from a garden hose (avoid pressure washing).

TOP INSTALLATION TIP
PLAN FOR THE HEAT

Summer means extra hours in the day, making it an appealing time to get started on a siding project. Properly plan for the heat by wearing sun protection (i.e. sunscreen and hats), taking shady breaks, staying hydrated and work earlier in the day to avoid the hottest temperatures.



TOP MAINTENANCE TRICK
TACKLE THAT PAINT PROJECT

Long summer days are the perfect time to tackle must-do home improvement projects. Give an instant facelift to a home's exterior by touching up small paint finish imperfections. Using a cotton swab, just apply paint to the bare area.

EMBRACE THE WEATHER

Fall weather provides ideal conditions for siding installation. While it's important to choose siding that braves every kind of weather condition, in many areas autumn is the most comfortable time to be doing outside construction.



TOP MAINTENANCE TRICK
SEAL IT UP

Before the chill of deep winter hits, replace caulk that has cracked, hardened or lost its seal. Save money on energy bills by keeping the warm air in and the cold air out.
